Buying stone slab is a big and exciting decision.

Please see below for some information to help you with the process.

Pricing

As a wholesale distributor, we cannot quote slab pricing to you. Pricing will come from your fabricator¹. However, we invite you to visit our showroom and slab gallery to view and select materials. Our price levels can give you a frame of reference as to how slabs are priced in relation to each other. We recommend you speak with your fabricator before holding any materials; they can advise you as to what our price levels mean for your project.

Selection Process

Since we have such a wide selection, we understand that it can be challenging to choose slabs. We encourage you to make multiple visits to see your options and look at potential slabs next to your cabinets, paint, window coverings or other aspects of your project. There are carts available in our warehouse to make this easier. Before you pursue putting slabs on hold, we recommend that you consult with your appointed fabricator as to the number of slabs needed, sizes needed, and pricing for your project. For out-of-town guests, this is especially important and ensures that you have a productive visit. To make sure that we have plenty of inventory available to you, slabs can only be held for a limited time - see the Hold Policy information below.

Hold Policy

If you've selected a fabricator, a 14-day hold can be placed with no obligation. Within 14 days (including weekends), we need a confirmed purchase order from your fabricator or the hold will be automatically released. Although you have 14 days, we highly recommend that you speak with your fabricator in the first few days to make sure that they have all the necessary information to put together their purchase order. If you do not have a fabricator, you may still hold slabs but we must receive the fabricator's name within 7 days.

Once we receive a confirmed purchase order, the hold can be extended to a cumulative total of 30 days, beginning on the day the slabs are first held. Within that time, the fabricator must pick up the slabs from our warehouse or pay in full. Slabs paid in full can be held in our warehouse an additional 60 days from the date of payment. If neither of these actions are taken, the hold will be released by our system.

PentalQuartz can only be held up to a maximum of 14 days.

This policy allows us to provide a wide variety of materials and maintain our inventory for you. Should you have any questions, please don't hesitate to ask our staff.

¹A fabricator is a specialty contractor who cuts and installs slab materials.
